Celebrating 60 years of OHMC

This is indeed a special year for the Ohio Huskie Muskie Club. Sixty years ago, the club was founded by Merrill Gilfillan and John Pelton. Merrill graduated from Ohio State with a degree in zoology and worked for the Ohio Division of Wildlife and then the Ohio Department of Natural Resources as a writer and editor of their educational materials. In addition to co-founding OHMC, he helped found the Buckeye Big Bucks Club and the Buckeye Trail. John spent most of his ODNR career in Wildlife, primarily in Fish Management. John was inducted into the Conservation Hall of Fame for his work in Wildlife including helping found OHMC. Our first President was Harold "Pooch" Curry, Vice President Henry Richard, and Secretary/Treasurer Robert Wilson. They are all charter members of the club along with Robert Johnson, Stanley Babicz, Casmier Drake and Stuart Asher. The original purpose of the club was to help record all the muskies caught each year. The club has proven to be an excellent vehicle for obtaining statewide information on muskie, which aided in evaluating fish management activities, and planning for the future of muskie fishing in Ohio. Currently that information is collected thru the Muskie Angler Log which along with captured tagging information provides a wealth of knowledge on our program lakes.

Some fun facts from our history. Since our inception, we have had over 4,150 individuals join the club as members. We have had our Summer Contest event for over 50 of those years with the first event in 1971. During the peak of that event, we were awarding a fully rigged boat to the winner. From 1977 thru 1984, we had over 500 entries for the Summer Contest with the peak being 1,056 entries in 1980. Those 1,056 fishermen caught 14 muskies over the two days at Pymatuning Lake; in 2020, at Piedmont, we had 43 anglers catch 26 muskies over the two days. Now are the golden years of muskie fishing in Ohio.

Since we started the Minnow Fund Outing in 2013, we have contributed over \$47,000 to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the stocking of muskies in Ohio.

In 1994 the Ohio Huskie Muskie Club incorporated as a 501 C3 non-profit organization. Today we are proud to be a sport fishing club dedicated to promoting better muskie fishing in the state while providing the Division of Wildlife with catch and harvest information. We seek to help experienced and new anglers be more successful in their pursuit of Ohio's top of the line predator fish.


