Once again it is time to prepare for our annual Division Day and Spring Outing. The Division Day will be held on Friday, June 8th at Clear Fork Reservoir in Lexington, Ohio. This is the day each year where members of the club volunteer to take Division of Wildlife personnel and Ohio outdoors writers on the water for a day of Muskie fishing

Festivities will begin at the large pavilion near the launch ramp at 8:00 am for coffee and donuts. Partners will then be assigned and we will hit the water until about 3:00 pm. Upon our return to the pavilion we will be treated to hamburgers and hot dogs on the grill. An award plaque will be presented to the guest who catches the largest Muskie in length.

The Spring Outing and Steak Fry will follow at Clear Fork Reservoir on Saturday, June 9th & Sunday, June 10th. This outing is for club members, their families, and invited guests. Guests must fish with a club member to be eligible for awards. For this event there is a \$15 registration fee per person to help cover the cost of the event. Please remember to buy 50/50, and raffle tickets as these also support the event. Please bring an extra dollar or two to donate to the minnow fund!

The registration will be set up at the large pavilion near the launch ramp. You may register Saturday from 6:00 am to 8:00 am. If you plan on fishing Sunday only, please notify an officer or trustee of the club in advance or contact one of us on the water. We will be monitoring VHF channel 68. You must register before you start fishing!

Starting at 4:00 pm Saturday we will have a potluck dinner. The club will furnish plates, utensils, and napkins. Make sure to bring a covered dish, your appetite, and a smile. This dinner will also feature a steak fry as usual. The ribeye steaks cost \$10.00 and must be ordered in advance. The 51st Ohio Huskie Muskie Clubs Annual Awards Banquet was held on March 17, 2012 at the Cherry Valley Lodge in Newark, Ohio. The event was notably absent of Mr. Fred Lederer, President of OHMC. Due to an ailment that was of an emergency nature, Fred was admitted to St. Luke's Hospital in Maumee, Ohio the day before the banquet. He has since been released and is recovering at home. I wish you a speedy recovery, you were truly missed at the banquet. Therefore every OHMC trustee stepped up to conduct the banquet and we felt that it went pretty well. There were a few glitches, but overall the membership reported to me that the event was a great success. There are two reasons for that, the fantastic preparation that Fred had put into the event, and the willingness of the Trustees and members to pitch in. In the business meeting, members voted on the lake nominations for our 43rd Annual Open Summer Contest in 2013. The winner was Pymatuning Reservoir in Andover, Ohio, with the event to be tentatively held on July 13th and 14th pending park approval. With three rods per angler permitted on Pymatuning, we look forward to plenty of fish being caught. Also, the members voted to consider moving next year's banquet to the Canton vicinity. The members voted to add an event to the OHMC schedule. The "Hawg Hunt Hoedown" is an event that will NOT count toward our overall event winner and will NOT have any entry fees or awards presented. This event has been conducted for several years by Mr. Guy Bechter, past president and member of Muskies Inc. Chapter 19. OHMC will join in participation of this event as a "closing of the season get together". The biggest change for the coming year will be that the members voted to change the way we determine our event winners. All OHMC events will now utilize a scoring system that is identical to the Muskies Inc. national scoring system. For those not familiar with the system, you will get 4 pts as long as the muskie is at least 30" and one full point for each full inch after 30". Finally, the members voted to re-name the Nite-Bite to the Gordon Selden Memorial Nite-Bite as an honor to a great fisherman and a wonderful gentleman.

Elections for officer positions were held during the business meeting. The OHMC officers for 2012 are as follows; Fred Lederer, President; Jeff Ferjutz, 1st Vice-President; Jake Lederer, Secretary; Paul Anderson, Treasurer. There were no nominations for 2nd Vice-President, and no one volunteered to step up for this position. There are currently several vacancies on the board of trustees, so if you are interested, we could sure use the help. Please see any trustee or officer.

Next, we took a moment for a blessing of the meal by club member Mary Jill Harshey. The food was excellent with beef bourguignon this year as a plated meal. We all had a great time and lots of fun with the fish stories that were being told.

ODNR attendees were Mr. Scott Hale, Inland Fisheries Program Administrator; Mr. Rich Carter, Fish Management Executive Administrator; Mr. Curt Wagner, Fish Management Biologist District Three; Mr. Tim Parrett, Fish Management Administrator, Ms. Deb Walters, Fish Management Supervisor District Five; Mike Greenlee, Fish Management Supervisor District Four; Kevin Page, Inland Fisheries Research Unit Research Biologist. Kevin presented information about a tag study to be conducted beginning later this year. The study will utilize external tags on every muskie stocked in every Ohio lake, for the next 10 years. In addition, for three lakes; Salt Fork, Alum Creek, and Leesville; the fish will have an electronic tag embedded in them to be read by scanners in some anglers' boats and by scanners at the outlet for the dams to monitor escapement. The program is estimated to cost \$384,000.00 and is another example of our state leading the way in muskie management. In my opinion, the stocking program here in The State of Ohio is second to none.

About one-half of those whom attended the banquet received a fishing related door prize. We had rods, tackle boxes, muskie lures, and many more items. A special thanks goes out to Ray McMaster of Muskie Fisherman Specialties, Jimmy Sturznickle of Jimmy's Bucktails, and Greg Them of Xtreme Musky Lures for setting up a booth at the banquet this year, and also all of the Ohio Huskie Muskie Club supporters who donated door prizes and prizes to raffle at this event.
