It is time for our Fifty-Third Annual Ohio Huskie Muskie Club, Inc. business meeting and annual awards banquet. We have a new location again this year with the festivities being held at **Prime 93**. We relocated this year in an attempt to put the banquet in a larger facility than last year while maintaining proximity to the geographic center of our membership. Holding our banquet in the Akron-Canton area last year resulted in a significant increase in attendance, and we hope that trend continues this year. The annual business meeting will be held from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM in the ballroom, followed by a one hour social time. All members are urged to attend. During the business meeting, you will be electing new officers and choosing your 2015 summer contest lake. We will also be considering alterations to the requirements for Dunmire and Release awards. Furthermore, we will be considering alterations to how those awards are physically produced. 


