### 50th ANNUAL AWARDS BANQUET

It is time for our Fiftieth Annual Ohio Huskie Muskie Club, Inc. business meeting and annual awards banquet. Being 50 years old is quite a milestone for a group such as ours. Something else to take pride in is that as best we can find out, OHMC is the Third oldest Muskie club still in existence, in the United States. Only the Wisconsin Musky Club and the Michigan Ontario Muskie Club are older than OHMC. They were founded in 1953 as opposed to OHMC being founded in 1961. Some things to keep an eye out for will be some special 50th anniversary items available from our list of club merchandise items.

Another way we would like to celebrate the event is to have a "memory lane" of older OHMC items, memorabilia, photos, trophies and such to have on display at the 2011 Banquet. Several members have already donated or loaned us items from their years of membership with OHMC. We will accept just about anything of interest, related to the club, musky stocking, or musky hatchery program. We will carefully handle your original items you wish to loan to the club and we will be equally happy to accept any duplicates you could offer us for the event. So please take a little time and see what you might have in your trophy room or file drawer at home, talk to your parents or grand-parents that may have gotten you started musky fishing in the first place. Let's see what kind of interesting items we all can come up with and then piece together a real nice walk down memory lane thru "50 years of hunting 50 inchers!".

The location will be the same as last year with the festivities being held at Cherry Valley Lodge. The address is 2299 Cherry Valley Road, Newark, Ohio. Please make your room reservation by calling Cherry Valley Lodge at 800-788-8008. Be sure to mention that you are with the Ohio Huskie Muskie Club to get your discount. You will need to provide a credit card number to hold your room.

The annual business meeting will be held from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM in the ballroom, followed by a one hour social time. All members are urged to attend. During the business meeting, you will be electing new officers and choosing your 2012 summer contest lake among many other issues. You must be a paid up member to vote in the meeting.

The banquet opening will start at 6:00 PM followed by our dinner and award presentations. The banquet meal will be \$30 per person for adults and \$15 for age 12 and under. The adult meal will feature a 5oz pork loin with side dishes and dessert. The youth meal will consist of chicken tenders, fries, fruit, dessert and a drink. Registrations for the dinner and seating will be held in the main

hall at the entrance to the banquet hall. During registration, you will receive a ticket for the door prize drawing and arrange your seat designation. Seating assignments will be first come – first served. We are concerned that you be able to sit with the party that you came with and will make every effort to accommodate you with the limited seating.

Banquet reservations must be **received by March 4**th as we need to notify the lodge of our exact number by March 5th. DO NOT WAIT to send in your reservation for this once-in-a-lifetime celebration. We cannot accept registrations received later, so please don't ask. Mail your registration early!

As usual we will have door prizes, a 50/50 drawing, and merchandise raffles. One of the items that will be raffled off is a custom built OHMC 50th anniversary one-of-a-kind rod that was built by trustee Max Reiner. Finally, the OHMC will be conducting our 14th Swap Meet for you to participate in. The "Tackle Lure, Swap, Buy Meet" will be held at the same time that vendors are displaying their tackle. The time for the "Swap Meet" set-up is 12:00 PM and will last until 5:30 PM. We have a limited amount of tables that will be available for this event. If you have any old tackle, lures, or any other fishing items that you would like to trade, sell, or give away, please include a note when you return your registration. As the banquet approaches, we will all have cabin fever. It has been scientifically proven that buying, selling, or even handling musky tackle can alleviate the symptoms of cabin fever. 
