## 43<sup>rd</sup> Annual O.H.M.C.inc. Open Summer Contest

It is time to prepare for our 43<sup>rd</sup> annual open summer contest to be held at Pymatuning Lake, Andover, Ohio on July 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Registration will be held at the beach pavilion area near the causeway. Registration will be open on Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM and will resume Saturday, July 13<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM. We will also have registration on Sunday on an as-needed basis. **Please contact an officer ahead of time if you know you will only fish on Sunday.** Entry fee registration donations will be \$20.00. As always this contest is open to the public. Fishing hours are from 6:00 AM Saturday until 2:00 PM Sunday (You can fish all night). All fish must be turned in by 3:00 PM Sunday. We will be offering a donation only pancake breakfast at the registration area on Saturday morning. All proceeds will go directly to the minnow fund so bring your appetite!

Please remember Pymatuning is a 20 horsepower restricted lake which is strictly enforced and all boating safety equipment is required. All state and local boating rules and regulations shall be observed.

There will be trophies awarded for the top three places. There will not be a trophy for kept fish as done in the past as we strongly promote catch and release. Remember, our awards are based on a point system (4 points for the first 30" with a point for each additional inch). Each boat will be given a boat packet containing contest information, **PLEASE READ THE CONTEST RULES CAREFULLY**.

Each angler who registers will be given a ticket at registration for the door prizes that will be drawn after the Grand Prize GoPro 3 HD Video Camera and \$250 Cash drawing. The award ceremony and the drawing will start at 3:00 PM sharp after fishing closes on Sunday, at the contest headquarters. You will need a raffle ticket to participate in the GoPro 3 HD Video Camera and \$250 Cash drawing. Your boat package will contain raffle tickets for you to buy in case you did not get any earlier in the year. If you can, please buy an extra raffle ticket at the event, as the proceeds are used to help fund OHMC events for the following year. Last year we enjoyed some great fishing and fantastic camaraderie. We look forward to seeing you at Pymatuning Lake !

Fred also pre-fished on Thursday and went 4 for 8 and included a 49" Clearfork pig! All trophies will be presented at the 2014 OHMC Awards Banguet to be held in March.

Saturday's steak fry was again prepared by club member Jerry Rice. Jerry did a fantastic job and I want to personally thank him for taking time from his fishing to cook steaks for all of us. Jerry was a true gentleman and a great chef who cooked each steak to everyone's choice of temperature. Great job on the steaks Jerry!
