

40th Annual O.H.M.C. inc. Open Summer Contest

It's time to prepare for our 40th annual open summer contest to be held at Salt Fork Lake, Cambridge, Ohio on July 10th and 11th 2010. Registration and headquarters will be held at the Main Marina ramp across from the main beach area. There will not be a tent this year. We will be using the pavilion near the ramp.. Registration will be Friday, July 9th from 5:00PM until 8:00 PM and will resume Saturday from 6:00 AM until 8:00 PM. We will also have registration on Sunday for the latecomers. Please call me ahead of time if you know you will only fish on **Sunday.** Entry fee registration donations will be \$15.00. As always this contest is open to the public. The last contest that was held at Salt Fork Lake was 2005, we had 82 anglers in the contest and 22 muskies were caught. That was the year in which the lake was draw down. Salt Fork is a great fishery and is well known for having some very large muskies there. With water levels at normal Summer Pool, I'm sure we can expect some nice muskies this year.

Salt Fork is an unrestricted horsepower lake but there are no wake zones and they are strictly enforced and all boating safety equipment is required. All state and local boating rules and regulations shall be observed. It is unlawful to operate a watercraft under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Obey all navigational buoys and swim only in designated areas.

There will be trophies awarded for the top three places in the Sportsman division. There will not be a trophy for kept fish as done in the past as we strongly promote catch and release. A plaque award will be awarded at a later time to the angler who releases the most muskies by total inches. (Two or more muskies will qualify.) Each boat will be given a boat packet containing contest information, **PLEASE READ THE CONTEST RULES CAREFULLY**. Each angler who registers will be given a ticket at registration for the door prizes that will be drawn after the Grand Prize 50-50 drawing. The award ceremony and the drawing will start at 3:00PM sharp after fishing closes on Sunday, at the contest headquarters. You will need a raffle ticket to participate in the Grand Prize 50-50 drawing.

The grand prize at the 2009 open summer contest payed out about \$1500 last year. Use the money toward buying what boat you want or buy that needed items for your existing boat. The winner is responsible for all taxes. The forms W9 and 1099 will be sent to the IRS. Your boat package will contain three raffle tickets for you to buy in case you did not get any earlier in the year. If you can, please buy a few extra raffle tickets at the event, as the proceeds are used to help fund OHMC events for the following year.

We again this year have many other raffle prizes and door prizes such as rods and reels, gift certificates, and many other miscellaneous prizes. Winner of the Grand Prize 50-50 does not need to be present to win. Tickets and information can be obtained from club members. Local sponsors or by calling, writing, or e-mailing the OHMC President (Fred Lederer). Remember to patronize these sponsors because with out them we would not be successful. Neil O'Brien (OHMC Trustee) caught a 40 by casting as well, and that fish was good enough to earn him the plaque for the biggest muskie caught by the guides, no fish were caught by the guests which is very unfortunate. But it is musky fishing and all guests said they enjoyed the day and the lunch provided by OHMC. Trustee Max Reiner was our grill master for the day. Thanks Max!

The Division Day event was followed by the 2010 Spring Outing and Steak Fry on June 12, & 13. Saturday was a bit warmer and the weather varied with clear skies and overcast. A few showers here and there set the tone for a very wet night of storms and one severe thunder storm later in the night. With the widely varied weather the muskies were equally varied. A few members were able to get slimed with 10 fish caught on Saturday and another 7 caught on Sunday. Most of us enjoyed a boat ride. A couple members were able to boat multiple fish and there was a lot of radio chatter about lost fish. I was a victim of fish-on and fish-off as well. At the end of the event, Junior member Logan Anderson was able to hold onto the fist place trophy with a 43-1/2" muskie. Second place was captured by a new member Aaron Blake with a 43" muskie. Both of these fish were caught on Saturday. Trophies for the event will be handed out at the Annual Awards Banquet in March of 2011. Remember that will be the kickoff of our 50th anniversary too!

Saturday's steak fry was again prepared by Max Reiner who treated each tender ribeye steak as if it was his own. Gently rubbed with seasoning and tenderly placed on the grill, and cooked to everyone's choice of temperature. Great job again on the steaks Max! I also want to thank the OHMC officers and trustees for all their hard work to make the event a success. Jeff Ferjutz, Paul Anderson "Logans Dad", Greg Hastings, Neil O'Brien, Aaron Kirkingburg, Roger Hayes, George Dickson, and Jake Lederer. I hope I got everyone who worked the event.
