

Piedmont Muskie Munch

October 24th, 2020

Event Guidelines and Schedule



- 1. All fish must be caught between 7:30 AM and 5:00 PM Saturday, October 24th
- 2. All fish caught must be turned in to Tournament director no later than 5:30 PM at the Piedmont Marina launch ramp .
- 3. Fish must be 30 inches minimum to qualify.
- 4. Winners will be determined by the longest fish caught. The angler with the longest fish will be awarded first place.
- 5. If there is a tie for first place, all anglers tied will be awarded first place.
- 6. No witness is required. All fish must be successfully released to qualify. If a fish dies or is kept, that fish will not qualify.
- 7. All persons in a boat must be entered in the event.
- 8. If an angler chooses to participate in the optional "Big Fish" pool then they do so at their own risk. The winner will be based on the largest fish turned in. No photos will be looked at, so don't bother to take a photo on a measuring board. This can be a controversial item and if you are concerned about potential cheating then DO NOT ENTER. Ties will not be broken; the prize will be split among tie entrants.
- 9. Decisions of the tournament director will be final.
- 10. No fish will be reported to either the Ohio Muskie Angler Log or to Muskies Incorporated. It is the anglers' responsibility to report fish caught.

All activities will be conducted at the Piedmont Marina Parking Lot.
