Ohio Huskie Muskie Club and the Minnow Fund

The Minnow Fund is a unique way to help the Division of Wildlife maintain a quality muskie stocking program in Ohio. There is a Minnow Fund Coordinator, currently Elmer Heyob, who works with the DOW to identify a wish list of items they desire to help the stocking program. When a club, like OHMC raises funds for the Minnow Fund, we hold the money until that need is communicated to us, at which point we cut a check to the vendor supplying the item to the DOW. We have supported the Minnow Fund for many years but have kept detailed records since we started the Minnow Fund outing in 2013. In the nine years since 2013, we have written checks totaling \$47,086.79 to various vendors supplying minnows and equipment to the DOW. In the state, the Minnow Fund has also received contributions from the Muskie Inc. chapters 19,23,41,56 and 18 as well as some money from the Hugh Becker fund connected to a chapter in Minnesota. The Minnow Fund has also received money from the Mike Money Lure Raffle Fund as well as additional individual fundraising efforts. In total, since 2013, the Minnow Fund contributions from all sources has totaled \$138, 616.44. The contributions have been used to buy \$84,601 in minnows, \$23,815 in readers, tags and antennae for the tracking study, \$12,793 for equipment such as pump impellers, nets and a custom muskie minnow hauling tank, and \$17, 405 for vegetation treatments so we can find the muskie in the ponds when they are ready to be stocked.

As an OHMC member you should be proud of the stocking program in Ohio as well as the key role we make in insuring the ongoing success of the program.


